Subject:

Install School Bus Stop or Pedestrian Crossing signs and installation of crosswalk pavement markings at intersection of Sentinel Drive & Madera Street near Sentinel Park.

Details:

Referral was make by Ald. Cummings in response to residents who want some signing to warn of bus drop off or some type of pedestrian crossing signing. Engineering staff presented some options at the meeting. The committee agreed that an S3-1 "school bus stop ahead" sign with symbols was the sign appropriate for this location. Signs will be located on eastbound and westbound Sentinel Drive. The committee also endorsed the installation of crosswalk markings on all 4 legs of intersection.

The Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

The cost to install signing, generally, would be around \$200 and covered by the 2018 B&G Sign Budget (3310.54141)
