Elizabeth Busch. Applicant was invited due to a possession of controlled substance and drug paraphernalia charges in October of 2017. Applicant stated she has learned from her mistakes and this will not happen again. Ms. Busch, agent for Walgreens stated she was made aware of these charges when the application was submitted and is in full support of Ms. Spicer obtaining an Operator License to work at Walgreens. Ms. Busch stated that Mya would be supervised from a leadership staff member.

Alderman Rodriguez stated that she finds both charges quite concerning especially since the applicant is currently under 21 years of age and will have a lot of responsibility with checking customer identifications to ensure she does not sell to minors.

Alderman Johnson agreed with Alderman Rodriguez and stressed the importance of the applicant being responsible and adhering to the liquor laws.

Mya stated that she has become more responsible and will properly check identifications and follow all liquor laws.
