

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

WAUKESHA TRANSIT COMMISSION

Service Adjustments Including the Elimination of Route 16 Effective January 7, 2019 REVISED November 21, 2018

A public hearing has been scheduled by the City of Waukesha Transit Commission for **Thursday, December 6, 2018 at 5:30pm in the Common Council Chambers at Waukesha City Hall, 201 Delafield Street, Waukesha**, for the purpose of considering service adjustments including the elimination of Route 16 proposed to be effective January 7, 2019. A complete list of changes is listed below. The Route 16 is a shuttle route that operates one morning trip per weekday from the Transit Center to the Easter Seals facility on Airport Rd. Easter Seals has informed the Transit Commission that it is ending its onsite program that Route 16 was designed to serve. Ridership on this route has significantly declined over the past year and is anticipated to further decline once the program at Easter Seals ends. The Route 16 Trip is proposed to be replaced with a 7:40 am Route 3 trip. The other proposed trip eliminations are due to low ridership.

Proposed Adjustments

1. Elimination of Route 16
2. Elimination of the Route 6 5:45 pm Weekday Outbound Trip (From the Transit Center to Badger Drive)
3. Elimination of the Route 5/6 8:24 pm Inbound & 8:50 pm Outbound Saturday Trips
4. Elimination of the Route 2 8:18 pm Saturday Inbound Trip (From Target to the Transit Center)
5. Elimination of the Route 1 service to the Brookfield Highlands Apartments in the Town of Brookfield.

At the hearing, the Waukesha Transit Commission and staff will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the proposed changes in service. Comments may also be submitted in writing up to the date and time of the public hearing to Waukesha Metro Transit, Public Hearing Comments, 2311 Badger Drive, Waukesha, WI 53188 or e-mailed to transit@waukesha-wi.gov.
