



FINAL CONCEPT

Description: Focusing much of the active recreation opportunities to the area by the south entrance, this concept maintains a soft separation between uses. Centered around a new community building, the west side of the site offers ample parking, trail connections and a battery of pickleball courts. This concept also offers a large flexible recreation space suitable to soccer, la crosse or other organized sports. A path system circulates throughout the site offering multiple routes for walking, snowshoeing or skiing. Designed as an asset to the site, a series of biofilter areas cascade through the site as they treat stormwater.
