Dear Mayor Reilly,

On Thursday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, the city of Waukesha received a request from the Housing Action Coalition of Waukesha County to operate a temporary homeless shelter at the old Fire Station #3 located at 1210 Century Drive. The Waukesha Fire Department has researched this issue, and it is possible to use this location when the following conditions are met:

- Smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are installed throughout all areas that individuals will be sleeping in.
- The building's HVAC equipment to be serviced and inspected to ensure it is operating properly.
- The building generator to be inspected and tested.
- The emergency lighting and exit lighting repaired where necessary.
- Fire extinguishers to be installed in accordance with NFPA 10.

The Waukesha Fire Department will need to conduct an inspection prior to opening to determine what areas can be used for sleeping quarters. This inspection will also determine the capacity for the shelter.

When these conditions have been complied with it would be acceptable to operate the shelter as a temporary use under state of Wisconsin administrative code as SPS 361.03 (12).
