

Subject:

Rescind existing parking zones that say "No Parking, 6am to 6pm, Except Saturdays, Sundays, Holidays" on the south side of Wisconsin Avenue and approve "2 Hour Parking, 9am to 6pm, Except Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays" from 110 feet east of N. West Avenue to 90 feet west of Maple Avenue. All existing zones that say "No Parking Any Time" on the south side of Wisconsin Avenue shall remain in place from N. West Avenue to N. Barstow Street.

Details:

This item was referred by Ald. Helgestad to consider removing parking restrictions on the south side of Wisconsin Ave. Items No. ID#19-0432, 0433 and 0434 are all related to removing parking restrictions on Wisconsin Avenue. The locations listed would be signed 2 Hour Parking and would benefit the greater downtown area when parking is in high demand. Engineering staff does not have an issue with this request.

The Building and Grounds Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.
