Subject:

The fire department is seeking approval from the Finance Committee and the Common Council to accept a \$10,000 grant from State Farm to support our fire prevention activities in the community.

Details: The Fire Department, Fire Prevention Bureau submitted and was awarded the State Farm Good Neighbor Citizenship Company Grant. The grant is for \$ 10,000 and will be used to create a Safe Community Program. The Safe Community Program will include enhancing the fire prevention program by updating materials used for the Fire Safety House and Kindergarten Prevention Programs and Hands-only CPR training; include a home safety component that will allow us to ensure that residential properties are safe with proper smoke/ carbon monoxide detectors and that we communicate about fire safety in the home (smoke/carbon monoxide detector installation for those residents in need, as well as Smoke Alarms Saves Lives door tag to those properties directly surrounding a property that had a fire). Attached is the award letter and acknowledgment of contribution from State Farm.
