Subject:

Rescind the existing parking zones on Frederick Street that say 2 Hour Parking, 8am to 4pm, except Saturday Sunday and Holidays on the east side from Ellis Street to Lincoln Avenue and on the west side from Ellis Street to Pearl Street. Said area will revert back to open parking.

Details:

This item was brought forward by Ald. Moltzan. The existing 2 hour parking zones in the state area are very old and do not reflect the parking needs for this area anymore. These existing zones were established in 1978 and 1980. The signs are very faded and, rather than replace them, they are be requested to be removed and the area returned to open parking. There will be no cost.

The Building and Grounds Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.
