RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes shall place the following official traffic signs and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

The following resolution was approved at the July 15, 2019, Building and Grounds meeting and brought forward to the August 6, 2019, Common Council Meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

ID#19-0949 Increase luminaire wattage with 250 watt LED equivalent light on the WE Energies light pole located on south side of Racine Avenue at Cheviot Chase. ID#19-0950 Install a School Zone Pedestrian Signing at the crosswalk on Summit Avenue at Hine Avenue. ID#19-0951 Approve No Parking Any Time on the west side of Frederick Street from Porter Avenue to E. Broadway. ID#19-0952 Rescind the existing parking zones on Frederick Street that say 2 Hour Parking, 8am to 4pm, except Saturday Sunday and Holidays on the east side from Ellis Street to Lincoln Avenue and on the west side from Ellis Street to Pearl Street. Said area will revert back to open parking. ID#19-0953 Rescind previously approved ID#15-3903 "Install Deaf Child Area signing in the 1100 block of N. Bel-Ayr Drive. ID#19-0954 Approve installation of a Deaf Child Area sign on Cody Court near the intersection of Crestwood Drive.
