### Subject:

Establish merge signing on E. Sunset Drive at Speedway east of Les Paul Avenue.

#### Details:

This item was brought forward by Ald. Cummings to review issues with traffic merging on E. Sunset Drive east of Les Paul Avenue and at the entrance to the Speedway gas station. Engineering staff presented several options to the Committee on creating a better merge condition for eastbound traffic. The options ranged from additional signing at low cost to full reconstruct at very high cost. Staff presented Option 3 which was to install new pavement marking on eastbound E. Sunset Drive to allow for two lanes of traffic to travel eastbound to Guthrie Road. The Committee unanimously agreed that Option 3 should be implemented. The Committee voted unanimously to approve Option 3 and to approve using \$3,100 to fund the pavement markings. The \$3,100 will come out of the Building and Grounds Safety Projects account #3310.54141.

# **Options & Alternatives:**

Five options were presented at the meeting and Option 3 was recommended by Staff. Option 3 which was to install new pavement marking on eastbound E. Sunset Drive to allow for two lanes of traffic to travel eastbound to Guthrie Road.

# **Financial Remarks:**

Staff will be requesting to use \$3,100 of the Building and Grounds special projects budget, account # 3310.54141.

### **Executive Action:**
