

## Subject:

Review and act on the Contract for Archeological Services for the City of Waukesha's 2022 STP St. Paul Ave. Reconstruction project.

# Details:

In 2017, the City applied for federal funding for the reconstruction of W. St. Paul Avenue from Mountain Avenue to Madison St. In 2019, the City received approval to enter into a State Municipal Agreement (SMA) for design and construction for this project with an 80% federal and 20% city funded cost share.

In June of 2019, the Department of Public Works solicited proposals from consultants to provide design services for the preparation of the traffic study. The request was sent out to three consultants and three responded with proposals. After reviewing the proposals, the City's review team chose UW-Milwaukee. The scope of their services is attached with a lump sum price of \$8,257.96.

#### **Options & Alternatives:**

The other consultant could be chosen, but UW-Milwaukee is recommended due to their experience and expertise along with the cost considerations.
