

#### Subject:

Adopting rules of procedure for Landmarks Commission appeal hearing..

#### Details:

If the Landmarks Commission denies an application for a certificate of appropriateness, the applicant can appeal the denial. The appeal goes before the Common Council. Such an appeal will come before the Council at a special meeting to be held December 10, concerning the demolition of the Moor Mud Baths building. There is not much guidance in the ordinance for the procedure of the appeal hearing, but it is important for the parties to know in advance what to expect at the hearing, so they can prepare properly for it. Proposed rules for the hearing accompany this cover sheet in a resolution. A memo also accompanies this cover sheet, with more information.
