# Subject:

Create a No Parking Zone at Collins Street at the entrance to Metal-Tech. I believe it would be south of the driveway. To correct a line of sight issue when pulling out of the driveway onto E. St. Paul Avenue.

### **Details:**

This item was brought forward by Ald. E. Payne on behalf of owners of Metal-Tek. Drivers exiting the factory on Collins Street going north have a hard time seeing eastbound vehicles on E. St. Paul Avenue. In order to increase the vision distance for northbound drivers, a sign saying No Parking Here to Drive is recommended to be placed at 105 feet west of centerline of Collins Street to remove the parked cars. The total cost to install the sign for this parking zone would be around \$100.

The Building and Grounds Committee voted unanimously to approve this item.

The cost for installing signing will be around \$100 and covered by the 2020 Building and Grounds Sign Budget (3310.54140).
