The entry of the public as necessary for them to register, cast votes, and other election-related activities. Parking of vehicles in designated areas as required for loading and unloading equipment, and for the convenience of poll workers and voters. er shall provide access to the Property by the City no later than 6 a.m. on the day of elections, and shall maintain continuous access to the erty by City employees, poll workers, observers, officials, and voters on the day of election until the polling place closes and all postion administrative activities are concluded by the City. Owner shall provide access to the Property as reasonably requested by the City on
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Juppii	ay before elections for load-in and placement of equipment and supplies, and the day after elections for removal of equipment and lies.

City shall not use any equipment rated to draw more than 15 amps without the ional permission of the Owner.
	may place signs and informational materials on and in the Property to identify the Property as a polling place and to direct voters to and the polling place.
	shall keep the portions of the Property used for election activities clean and free of debris, refuse, and after conclusion of the election ities shall leave the Property in the condition it was in before the City's entry.
	shall be responsible for the safety and security of all poll workers, observers, election officials, and voters while they are in the portions of Property used as a polling place, and shall follow all directions of the Owner regarding access to other areas of the Property.
as a r	shall indemnify and hold the Owner, and Owner's employees, officers, agents, and volunteers harmless from any liabilities that may arise result of the use of the Property by the City as a polling place, except for those liabilities arising from the gross negligence of the Owner Owner's employees, officers, and agents.
	shall obtain an endorsement to its general liability insurance policy naming the Owner as an additional insured, and shall provide Owner as certificate of insurance showing that Owner is an additional insured.
	City shall be responsible for repair or replacement of Owner's real or personal property that is damaged or destroyed by individuals on er's property for the purpose of election polling activities.
