2019 Board of Public Works Collection System Progress Report -

Summary

Jonathan Schapekahm, P.E., presented the annual CMOM Collection System Progress Report. He highlighted several items including that 92% of the sewer system has been televised. Sewer rehabilitation/ replacement of 5 miles of lateral replacement was completed. Bulk of the work in 2019 was ferrous force main replacement at 27,044 LF (5.1 miles). On track to replace them or retire them within 3 years. Peak flow reduction saw another elevation from the prior year. Fourth year above average precipitation seen a shaving of the peaks. Updated Development Handbook for the 2020 year. Lastly, continue seeing good responses to control odor, none has been logged in the system in 2019.
