

McDonald's, 1635 E. Main Street - Minor Site Plan & Architectural Review

## Details:

McDonald's is proposing to update the décor of their store at 1635 E. Main Street including changes to the exterior. This store is part of a multi-tennant building, shared with Shell station of the same address. The proposal is to upgrade to the new McDonald's façade style, as we have seen done at other stores across the City. Most notably, the traditional McDonald's mansard will be removed, to be replaced with new materials including stucco and tile as used at other locations. A new interior décor will also be done with this project. The gas station portion of the storefront, NW corner, will not be change with this project. The McDonald's entrance at the NE corner of the building will now be defined with a dark tile accent, a vertical stucco wall will replace the former mansard around all sides. Staff suggests the aluminum awnings above the drive-thru windows be extended to provide more relief and diversity along the east elevation which is highly visible from Les Paul Parkway. Any landscaping which is damaged or removed during construction must be replaced. New detector loops will be installed in the drive-thru area, but the traffic pattern will remain the same, with new order boards to replace the existing ones.
