

Subject:

Review and act on a Technical Service Contract for the Sanitary Sewer Televising for 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023.

Details:

There are approximately 250 miles of sanitary sewer in the City and accordance with our Capacity, Management, Operation and Maintenance (CMOM) Plan on file with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the City has a goal to televise approximately 10% of the sanitary system every year as part of an on ongoing inspection program.

The Department of Public Works solicited proposals from sewer televising firms to provide these services. Three firms responded to the request for proposals. After reviewing the proposals, Great Lakes TV Seal, Inc. was the low price for this work.

Their prices are as follows for the following years

- 2020 \$0.42/Lin Ft = \$52,500.00
- 2021 \$0.43/Lin Ft = \$53,750.00
- 2022 \$0.44/Lin Ft = \$55,000.00
- 2023 \$0.45/Lin Ft = \$56,250.00

Options & Alternatives:

The other consultants could be chosen, but Great Lakes TV Seal, Inc. is recommended due to their experience and expertise along with the cost considerations.
