The bids for theGreat Water Alliance Contract Package 6 Return Flow Pipeline were opened at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday May 14, 2020. There were three (3) bidders which are shown in the table below. Action by the Board of Public Works is scheduled for their concurrent meeting on May 21, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. and action by the Common Council is scheduled to occur at their June 2, 2020 meeting.

All contractors were pre-qualified and have met all bid requirements, including utilization of a minimum 10% Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) and minimum 30% Local Business Participation. The contract includes approximately 59,554 LF of 30-inch ductile iron pipe and the limits are from the terminiation of Contract Package 5 on Small Rd between Calhoun Rd and Moorland Rd in the City of New Berlin to the outfall property south of W. Oakwood Rd in the City of Franklin adjacent to the Root River.

In concurrence with the Letter of Recommendation from Greeley & Hansen and Black & Veatch, Waukesha Water Utility recommends the below motion.

Recommended Motion: Move to approve the low bid, totaling **\$60,200,000.00** with S.J. Louis Construction, Inc., for the Return Flow Pipeline Contract Package 6 project.
