

Bridges System libraries begin reopening

WAUKESHA — The Bridges Library System, which has 24 libraries in Waukesha and Jefferson counties, is beginning phased reopenings of the physical buildings in the coming weeks, a press release states.

The libraries will be following guidelines and recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, county public health departments and Wisconsin

Department of Public Instruction for decisions regarding opening procedures.

“Each library plans to institute thorough sanitation and hygiene protocols to ensure the safety and health of library users and staff,” the release states. “Visitors are encouraged to maintain social distancing. Wearing a mask also is encouraged, and may be required in some libraries.”

The release states each library will have its own open date with service protocols and hours of operation.
