
Re: Madison Street – Town of Genesee Agreement

As part of the Madison Street Reconstruction project, the transition back to the existing roadway width will require the encroachment of approximately 310 feet of roadway into the Town of Genesee jurisdiction. This transition includes a cut in the roadway elevation of approximately three (3) feet to improve line of sight visibility. Therefore, an agreement regarding this work must be in place and is attached herein.


The location is shown on the attached exhibits.

### LETTER OF AGREEMENT MADISON STREET RECONSTRUCTION

This Letter of Agreement (this "AGREEMENT") is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2020, by and the City of Waukesha Water Utility, hereinafter referred to as (the "UTILITY") and the Town of Genesee, a Wisconsin municipal corporation (the "TOWN").

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the UTILITY desires to construct water transmission facilities in the public right-ofway of Madison Street from Prairie Song Drive to the western City of Waukesha, hereinafter referred to as (the "CITY) corporate limits, hereinafter referred to as (the "PROJECT"); and

WHEREAS, the UTILITY will also make certain public improvements (the "PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS") to Madison Street to meet the current City street cross-section standard and to meet the minimum sight distance standard;

**AND, WHEREAS**, the reconstruction of Madison Street in the CITY will necessitate the reconstruction of approximately 310 feet of Madison Street in the TOWN as described on Exhibit A attached hereto;

**AND, WHEREAS**, the Town Engineer has reviewed and on May 21, 2018 approved the construction plans for the PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS;

**AND, WHEREAS**, the UTILITY has contracted for the watermain extension and the reconstruction of Madison Street and the cost for the reconstruction of Madison Street in the TOWN is \$41,571.66;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, UTILITY and TOWN agree as follows:

- 1. UTILITY shall reconstruct Madison Street per the approved plans at no cost to the Town of Genesee.
- 2. UTILITY shall be responsible for any damage to 310 feet of roadway reconstructed by the UTILITY until final acceptance of the PROJECT.
- 3. Road closure signage shall be installed by the UTILITY or their agent prior to the start of the reconstruction work.
- 4. UTILITY shall not issue final acceptance for the reconstruction work in the TOWN without the prior consent of the TOWN.
