<b>Subject:</b> 30 Minute Parking on the east side of N. Barstow Street from 160 feet to 60 feet south of Corrina Blvd centerline. Item Amended to: 2 Hour Parking, 7am - 7pm, Except Sundays and Holidays on the east side of N. Barstow Street from 160 feet to 60 feet south of Corrina Blvd. centerline.	

**Details:**

The design of the roadway has opened opportunities to have more on-street parking where it did not exist before. For this particular item, some parking stalls have been created on the east side of N. Barstow Street just south of Corrina Blvd. outside the liquor store. Staff has reviewed the parking in this area and determined that having a 30 Minute parking zone was appropriate for this new section of parking due to its close proximity to Discount Liquor and most persons using the stalls are patrons of the store. The committee discussed this item and motioned to revise the time to say 2 Hour Parking, 7am - 7pm, Except Sundays and Holidays to match the other parking zones in the downtown area.

**Financial Remarks:**

The cost for installing signs and marking related to the new parking zone has already been covered by the NW Barstow Street reconstruction project.

**Executive Recommendation:**

The Building and Grounds Committee approved this item at their August 3, 2020, meeting. Vote was not unanimous. This item will appear under the Building and Grounds Report for the August 18, 2020, Council meeting. For consistency of rules in this area, the Committee recommended 2 Hour Parking, 7am-7pm, Except Sundays and Holidays on the east of N. Barstow Street from 160 feet to 60 feet south of Corrina Blvd. centerline.
