Review and act on the request from David Saye for a one-time sewer credit for 3547 Howell Oaks Drive

Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.6(d) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, residential users may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as installation of a new swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

David Saye, on October 11, 2019, has requested to receive a credit for sewer service charges for a period of time ending August 20, 2019. His yard had a new lawn was installed late June and required extensive watering to establish it.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was calculated and compared with the heavy usage.

High Usage: 72,100 gallons

Estimated Additional Usage: 51,500 gallons

Calculated Refund (2019 - \$7.25 /1000 gal): \$373.38

Options & Alternatives:

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
