

Waukesha library reopens with limited hours

WAUKESHA — Since announcing limited hours “because several library staff needed to be quarantined” on social media Friday, the Waukesha Public Library reopened Monday under the limited hours.

Library Director Bruce Gay said six employees that work in the circulation department

are in quarantine right now because one employee had tested positive for COVID-19.

Gay said they learned of the news Friday morning, so they planned from there and announced the change in hours.

The library announced that until further notice, the hours will be from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. The library will be closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

“We continue to have all the staff and everybody coming in wearing masks,” Gay said. “We are socially distancing as much as possible. We have plexiglass up not only in the public areas but in the back staff areas ... we have spray bottles of disinfectant that we use on the equipment for the public, we use that regularly every day.”

The outdoor book return will remain open so individuals don’t have to enter the building to return their items.
