

Please approve the installation of a LED Flashing stop sign system for all four approaches at the intersection of Arcadian Avenue & Pleasant Street.

Details:

This item was referred by Ald. Miller in response to a study that was completed by Engineering staff for accident issues and non-compliance of stop signs at the intersection of Arcadian Avenue and Pleasant Street. Ald. Miller is requesting the expenditure of funds to purchase LED blinking stop signs at the intersection. The staff study report indicated support for a flashing system as means to reinforce awareness of the stop condition. The Department of Public Works does not have any issues with this item.

Financial Remarks:

If the committee approves this flashing stop system, it would be \$5,120 to purchase the system and City Garage staff would install it. The budget to fund purchase of the system would be the Building and Grounds Special Projects fund account no. 3310.54141 (\$5,000) and remaining \$120 would come out of the regular Building and Grounds sign budget, account n. 3310.54140.
