Dear Mr. Ausen,

I am writing on behalf of the City of Waukesha Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department, as the official with jurisdiction over the section 4(f) property in question, Grede Park in the City of Waukesha. The Parks Department has had an opportunity to coordinate and review plans on the subject WisDOT improvement project. The Parks Department concurs that there are no adverse impacts resulting from the proposed project to Grede Park, otherwise known as a section 4(f) property. We understand that as part of the project a temporary limited easement (TLE) will need to be obtained in order to conduct construction related activities within the boundaries of Grede Park. The approximate area to be covered under the TLE is 946.77 SF (0.02 acres) (see attached exhibit). The Parks Department recognizes the TLE as a temporary occupancy exception under section 4(f) of the US DOT Act. The Parks Department understands and agrees that:

- The land use is of short duration (defined as less than the time needed for the construction of the project).
- There is no change in ownership of the land.
- The scope of the work is minor in nature.
- There are no temporary or permanent adverse changes to the activities, features, or attributes of the property.
- The land will be fully restored to a condition at least as good as prior to the project.
