

Approval of Resolution Authorizing the Filing of the 2021 Federal Grants

## Details:

This item is to approve the resolution authorizing the Transit Manager to file the Transit Commission's Federal 2021 Grants with the Federal Transit Administration. The grants includes funds from the 5307, CMAQ, STP, and CRRSAA funding programs. The funds will be used for the following purposes:

5307 funds -used to partially fund the operations of the City and County transit systems for 2021. The total funds available is estimated at roughly \$1,000,000 split 50/50 between the City and County (\$500,000/each system)

Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds-used to fund future marketing expenses at 80%. A total of \$32,000 of CMAQ funds are available.

Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds-used to fund 80% of the cost of a replacement fixed route bus. A total of \$368,000 of STP funds are allocated to the City.

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplement Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funds-these are supplemental funds to the CARES Act funds to be used to assist operations at 100% reimbursement due to the COVID pandemic. The total funds available is estimated at \$4.09 million split 50/50 between the City and County (\$2,045,000/each system).

## **Options & Alternatives:**

There are no viable alternatives. The federal funds are critical to the operation of the City and County Transit Systems and capital projects.
