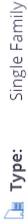

The remaining 8 training days are done throughout South East Wisconsin at locations like Petco, Home Depot, Pet Supplies +, Brookfield Square Mall, Mayfair Mall, SouthRidge Mall, Corner Of Brookfield, Dicks Sporting Goods, Hobby Lobby, Best Buy, Fiserv. Forum, Historic Third Ward, Blains Farm and Fleet, and Cabela's. We have established communication with every location and have sole permission to train on their

Insurance: Fully covered with renters insurance and business insurance through USAA.

Special Precautions that the Business takes:

Aggressive dogs needing rehab will undergo the same training but remain separated from all other dogs, humans unless properly handled by a trainer. Until the "aggressive dog" is no longer aggressive they remain soft muzzled around any and all persons/dogs that are not the trainer. Therefor the "aggressive dog" remains kenneled through out the day when not training and is let out separately to use the bathroom.

All dogs that book with us are required to be fully up to date on all shots for their age. We do not accept any dog under the age of 5 months (Maturity-Vaccine Requirements)

Regular Night time:

Board and train dogs will be kenneled at night time when they cannot be supervised 100% of the time. Dogs are kenneled at night time for the safety of them selves and the house. (Guidelines from Insurance company-Stated in our contract as a company policy) Board and train dogs have access to white noise machine, and scent diffusers to help with anxiety, this helps assure for nice peaceful nights of sleep.
