## RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes shall place the following official traffic signs and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

The following resolution was approved at the April 5, 2021, Building and Grounds meeting and brought forward to the April 20, 2021, Common Council Meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.

- ID#21-1993 Place two yield signs on Apache Pass on both the north and south side of the street where it intersects with Comanche Lane.
- ID#21-1994 Install signs that say "Turning Vehicles Yield to Pedestrians" at all 4 legs of the traffic signal at the intersection of E. Main Street and Manhattan Drive.
- ID#21-1995 Install a "Deaf Child" sign in the 300 block of Joris Avenue. One of District 13's resident, a toddler, is 23 months old and cannot hear.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall file this resolution in their office as part of the original City records.
