Shelf moves for first floor renovation.

There are 5 major sets of movements as part of the renovation. The library furniture plan map, included, has these numbered in red.

- 1. New Books. The new book section needs to be moved to the lobby's southeast wall.
- Fiction. The fiction collection, which is currently in the southwest main section of the library, needs to be moved to the northwest corner. Shelves in the fiction section are a mix of 84- and 66-inch units. The taller units should be moved to the west wall, with the shorter units closer to the atrium.
- 3. Large print books. Extra fiction units and the Spanish collection should be moved south of the fiction collection for the large print collection. Library staff will reshelve the large print collection to these shelves.
- 4. The Media collection will be moved to the space vacated by the fiction collection, leaving space for the new Markerspace.
- 5. The Serials collection in the Carnegie Room will be moved to the Local History collection space in the far northeast corner of the library. The Local History collection will be moved to new shelves in the Carnegie Room.

The order of these moves is not yet known and depends on the contractor's schedule.
