<b>Subject:</b> Please approve the repainting of existing crosswalk and stop bar markings and the replacement of all school zone crossing signs at the intersection of Arcadian Avenue and Oakland Avenue.	

**Details:**  
This item was referred by Ald. Rodriguez in response to traffic / pedestrian safety concerns on Arcadian Avenue, specifically at the Oakland Avenue intersection. In May and June of 2021, Engineering staff had conducted a traffic study of this area to develop a plan of action to address vehicular traffic and pedestrian safety issues. The study results show the subject improvements would benefit the overall traffic safety at this intersection. The Department of Public Works recommends approval of this item. The cost for installing new signing would be around \$200.

**Options & Alternatives:**  
A traffic study of the Arcadian Avenue was completed by staff that precipitated the subject item.

**Financial Remarks:**  
The cost for installing new signing would be around \$200 and covered by the 2021 Building and Grounds Signing Budget (3310.54140). It should be noted that the new signing related to this item will be reused in 2022 when Arcadian Avenue is reconstructed. Changing out this signing with new is intended to happen in August 2021 prior to school starting.

**Executive Recommendation:**  
The Department of Public Works recommends approval of this item.
