Justification for Equipment Replacement Fund Expenditure

The Waukesha Police Department has had a squad camera program for over 10 years and has had a desire to obtain body worn cameras in the past. However previous research has not made it economically feasible as the PD would be running two separate software systems which required an increase in staffing to manage the operations and records. Axon offers an integrated camera and data management system (Evidence.com) that would replace our current system MAVRS with Axon - Fleet 3 and provide Body Worn Cameras that operate from the same video software. This system also connects to our electronic control devices the Taser 7 and collects data from the units as they are armed, deployed, and disarmed. The video data can be redacted from the Axon software that comes with this proposed package and forwarded to the District Attorney's office for charging. It is exponentially
