

Final Site Plan and Architectural Review - Best Buy Office and Warehouse, 1822 Dolphin Dr - Addition of loading docks openings and overhead doors.

Details:

The applicant is requesting site, landscape, and architectural plan approval for the addition of seven (7) overhead loading dock openings and a new parking lot and drive aisles at the Best Buy Office and Warehouse building located at 1822 Dolphin Drive. The plan includes adding a drive lane and about 35 parking stalls on the west side of the existing building. This will allow for more employee parking and a full truck route around the building to access the new loading dock doors. The property currently does not appear to have enough parking to accommodate all of the employees working at the building. New stormwater facilities will be added west of the new parking area to accommodate the large amount of impervious surface being added.

The seven new loading dock doors will be added to the rear (north elevation) of the building and are not visible from Dolphin Drive or Marlin Court. There is a significant amount of existing trees and other vegetation screening this facility from the Hillcrest Park Apartments to the north. There are existing trees on the site but the applicant plans to supplement those with additional site landscaping along Dolphin Drive.

Options & Alternatives: The Plan Commission can make any changes to the Project Plan they feel are necessary.
