White Cane Safety Day PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, blindness and severe visual impairment affect approximately 100,000 Wisconsin residents; and

WHEREAS, the majority of these persons use travel aids, such as a white cane or a service animal to get around public streets and sidewalks and places of public accommodation; and

WHEREAS, these travel aids are universally recognized as symbols of representing vision loss; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's White Cane Law requires that motorists come to a full stop before approaching closer than 10 feet to a pedestrian using a white cane or service animal; and

WHEREAS, careful driving and fully stopping when pedestrians are in the crosswalk is beneficial to all residents, including children, elders, and people with disabilities; and

NOW THEREFORE, I, Shawn Reilly, Mayor of the City of Waukesha, proclaim October 15, 2021 as

White Cane Safety Day
