## Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as installation of a new swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

Roland Kelly Kramer, on September 7, 2021, requested a credit for sewer service charges for the time period of July 2021. During this period, a garden hose burst and discharged water into the backyard before it was discovered.

For comparison and calculation of a refund, the average water usage was compared with the period of heavy usage.
High Usage: 15,100 gallons
Average Usage: 5,849 gallons
Estimated Additional Usage: 9,251 gallons
Calculated Refund (2021-\$8.54/1000 gal): \$79.00
