“The House on Mango Street” is the selected 2021 Waukesha Reads title. Cisneros is an award-winning novelist, poet, essayist and short-story writer. She will answer questions on the novel, her writing process and her life.

“The House on Mango Street,” first published in 1984, won the Before Columbus Foundation’s American

Book Award in 1985 and is required reading in middle schools, high schools and universities across the country. It has sold over six million copies since its initial publication and has been translated into over twenty languages.
