For the last 125 years, Waukesha Public Library has been the cornerstone of Waukesha, evolving with the needs of each new generation.

While the original 1904 Carnegie building remains, five additions and renovations have transformed the building into a 70,000 square foot resource serving the information and entertainment needs of our community.

Now it's time to evolve again. This generation demands greater access to technology, more meeting and gathering spaces, and opportunities for hands-on learning.

The Library has begun a \$4.8 million effort to turn the page into the next chapter of our story.
