One mower has 5,376 hours of use logged, and the other had 1,469 hours logged before the display stopped working. Cemetery staff estimate that it most likely logged an additional 1,000 hours. By trading in two more specialized pieces of equipment, we will be able to purchase a more functional piece, helping our mowing operations be more efficient.

After an evaluation, the roofing experts have determined that the current 85 year old slate roof needs to be replaced. The roof is approximately 900 square feet. This project will consist of removing existing gutters, downspouts, edge metal and roofing down to deck, installing one layer of 1/2" HD ISO and one layer of EPDM, furnish and install metal edge, counterflashing, gutter and downspouts.

Justification/ How does this Increase Service to Residents?

Prairie Home chapel/administration building provides space for chapel funeral services, workspaces and record storage. Roof leaks have been fixed multiple times but will continue to happen and become more frequent with a deteriorating roof. Leaks cause damage to the building structure, carpet, furniture and computers. Leaks can also cause more severe damage to irreplaceable paper records.
