Mr. Albanese has installed metal stakes and yellow plastic chain to define the area around the bocce ball courts that he would like to include as a part of his licensed premise; he needs to purchase more chain from Menards - he went to 3 stores and bought the supply they had. The yellow chain will have signs indicating that the area is restricted and patrons should stay on that side of the chain.

The bocce ball season runs from May through October. Leagues are 3 nights per week; this decreases in the fall.

Ald. Rodriguez brought up a consequence for having operated without this area on their license for several years. Perry agrees that the fee is appropriate.
