- A. <u>ID#19-0015</u> Discussion/recommendation regarding Library Director's 2019 goals

Library Director Gay explained that he pulled items from the newly developed strategic plan to create his SMART goals for 2019. He welcomed feedback from the Committee for any changes or recommendations that they might suggest. Trustee Riebel commented that the goal of working to repair the front entry was more urgent to the plan. Trustee Ammerman questioned whether funding for the feasibility study was based on a partnership with the City and also securing private funding. Director Gay replied that in his most recent conversation with the City Administrator, Kevin Lahner indicated that the City would provide 2/3 funding if the Library could raise 1/3 privately for major capital projects.

Trustee Ammerman moved to recommend approval of the Library Director's 2019 goals. Trustee Sura seconded. Trustee Sura inquired about the dates for completion of the goals. Director Gay replied that goals need to be time bound in order for them to be SMART goals. Having deadlines gives the goal more focus. The motion to recommend approval of the Library Director's 2019 goals as presented carried unanimously.
