  - <u>ID#20-0389</u> The APPEAL OF Douglas Proulx for a dimensional variance from section 22.58(2)(a)(2) of the zoning code. If granted, the variance would allow for a new accessory building in excess of 150 sq. ft. at 1811 Milky Way Road, when no more than one accessory structure shall be erected on a lot in any residential district when the principal dwelling has an attached garage, and the accessory structure shall not exceed one hundred fifty (150) square feet in area.

If granted, the variance would allow for a new covered porch at 1462 Cleveland Ave., projecting up to six feet into the street yard, when only uncovered stairs, landings, and fire escapes may project into any yard.

• Registration must be submitted by 4PM on the day of the meeting start time to allow time for verification.

If you would prefer to not participate live in the meeting, you can submit comment at least one hour prior to the meeting by e-mailing CommDev@waukesha-wi.gov. You will need to include the specific meeting and item (from the list above) that your comment is for as well as your name and address.
