Ald. McElderry to the Plan Commission to request the City of Waukesha to reassess the STH 59 West Town Center Traffic Impact Analysis Updated (dated July 10, 2020) to accurately identify how much additional traffic volume will be diverted down River Valley Rd following the connection to STH 59. To request the City of Waukesha not to connect River Valley Rd to STH 59 until the Traffic Impact Analysis is updated to include the development's traffic impacts upon Fox Ridge West and Trillium Hill subdivisions, and until the final report is presented for public review and comment.

Ald.
