Kevin Lahner, City Administrator, presented this item. The current structure of the Public Works Department and Water Utility is being looked at in preparation to fill the Public Works Director vacancy to make sure the City is operating at peak efficiency. This is a good opportunity to take a step back and look at how we're operating. PowerPoint presentation (attached) summarized the recommendation such as the Water Utility's responsibility for the water returned to Lake Michigan and some level of coordination to make sure we're in compliance with our DNR permits and less overlap with the staff, including a way to coordinate rate increase and flatten the costs for the residents. It would be a fair independent review and make sure everyone is talked to and we are doing the things the right way and more efficiently. Ald. Payne supports doing a study and stated it has to be an in-depth of both departments and worded in the RFP to that effect. Kevin Lahner could write-up the scope of services before it goes on the street for their approval. Steve Kassens agrees and needs to see the detail of the scope assuring it's covering all the bases, and everything is reviewed. Al Pieper recommends approval
