This item was brought forward by Public Works and Transit. Staff has been working with Transit to adjust the street parking on Lawndale Avenue to better accommodate a bus coming northbound out of the new hospital driveway and turning left to westbound on Lawndale Avenue. The narrowness of Lawndale Avenue requires the bus to encroach into the parking lane. If a car is parked there, the bus cannot complete the turn. The subject distances describe the zone changes to accommodate a turning bus. The total cost for adjusting some signing will be around \$200.
