A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG A PORTION OF SILVERNAIL ROAD IN WAUKESHA, WISCONSIN

The governing body of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin, do resolve as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §66.0907 and Wauk. Mun. Ord. §6.115, the Common Council of the City of Waukesha hereby determines and directs that sidewalks shall be constructed along Silvernail Road, from STH318/Meadowbrook Road to Sussex Lane, as illustrated in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The sidewalks' construction shall comply with the requirements for width, material, and method of construction set forth in section 6.08 of the Waukesha Municipal Code, titled "Construction of Sidewalks."

Section 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be served upon the owner, or an agent, of each lot or parcel of land in front of which the work is ordered by publication in the Waukesha Freeman as a class 1 notice under chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and by mailing by 1st Class Mail.

Section 4. If an owner served notice under section 3 of this Resolution neglects for a period of 20 days after service of notice to lay the sidewalk, the City shall cause the work to be done at the expense of said owner. All work for its construction shall be let by contract to the lowest responsible bidder except as provided in Wis. Stat. 62.15(1).

Section 5. The Director of Public Works shall keep an accurate account of the City's expenses of laying the sidewalks in front of each lot or parcel of land and report the expenses to the City of Waukesha Treasurer. The Treasurer shall annually prepare a statement of the expense incurred in front of each lot or parcel of land and report the amount to the City Clerk. The amount charged to each lot or parcel of land shall be entered by the Clerk in the tax roll as a special charge, as defined under Wis. Stat. §74.01(4), against the lot or parcel of land and collected like other taxes upon real estate.

Section 6. The amount charged to each lot or parcel of land may be paid in 10 annual installments and the Treasurer shall prepare the expense statement to reflect the installment payment schedule. The City Clerk shall charge the amount to each lot or parcel of land and enter it on the tax roll as a special charge, as defined under Wis. Stat. §74.01(4),
