### Issue Before the Council:

This item is to review and act on proposed bus stop changes after assessing the first month of the June service changes. The proposed changes include:

1. Eliminate the bus stop on the west side of Grandview Blvd. just south of Michigan Ave. by Lowell Elementary School. Due to recent routing changes, there is another bus stop only 100 feet from this stop and this stop can be difficult to operate to.
2. Move the bus stop on Manhattan Dr. south of Moreland from the east side of the street to the west side of the street. The west side location would be better for the passengers and easier to operate to.
3. Add a bus stop on Sunset Dr. at the entrance to Meijer. This will allow passengers to get off at Meijer on the inbound trip (towards downtown) which would be particularly beneficial for passengers that live west of Meijer on Route 15 as the Route 15 no longer enters Meijer on the inbound trip.

### Options & Alternatives:

The options are to approve all, some, or deny all of the proposed changes.

The cost for the proposed changes would be no more than \$150 for the new bus stop which would be paid for from the Transit Operating budget.



