### 2. Narrative of Design Concepts:

## A Finches Journey:

This mural design features golden finches, golden rod and asters, all native to Wisconsin, in an abstract prairie like field. Finches remind us of the important attributes of joy, appreciation, high energy, optimism, and simplicity. They implore us to be mindful and responsible with Earth's resources while enjoying the journey of life. It is not about the final destination but truly enjoying the journey. Finches exemplify this through their flight patterns. These songbirds make their journey in flight into a dance, twisting and turning throughout the air for no other purpose besides enjoyment.

#### Metamorphosis, Monarchs, Milkweed:

This mural design illustrates the life cycle and metamorphosis of the Monarch butterfly from caterpillar to chrysalis, to butterfly on its host plant milkweed. Monarchs have become an endangered species and we can educate the public about their host plant milkweed to help them survive for generations to come. The hands represent our involvement as humans that can help them.

### A Few of My Favorite Things:

This mural design shows cardinals and sunflowers in a colorful dynamic composition. My grandmother's favorite bird and flower. Cardinals are often thought to bring messages from loved ones. I hope everyone can find peace and hold memories of loved ones dear when viewing this mural.

# 3. Materials to be used for art piece:

I am proposing painting on panels of 3mm dibond panels, aluminum panels with a pvc coating used in the sign industry. The panels would be primed, painted with exterior acrylic and spray paint, and coated with exterior varnish. The panels would be affixed to the wall with framing behind them to ensure a level mounting surface. I am proposing this method for all 3 areas but also open to painting directly on the wall if that is preferred for areas 1 and 2.

#### 4. Timeline:

All murals would be completed and installed by Oct 17th, 2025

5. Approximate dimensions for proposed artwork or structures.:

Location 1: 14ft x 14ft Location 2: 10ft x 20ft Location 3: 8ft x 14ft

6. Cost for the design, fabrication, installation, and artist fee.:

John Kowalczyk is multi-faceted artist working in mixed media paintings, murals, sculptures, community projects and larger than life installations that incorporate clashing patterns, bold colors, and rich layers of texture, narrative and history.
