I have created public artwork with cities, towns, corporations, and private individuals. Each of these experiences has a variety of different directions on the design and completion of the art. In many cases a successful piece of public art begins with the idea of collaboration. I enjoy working with panels or committees to create the perfect piece of original site-specific art for the space and the environment it will be residing. The desire of unity in our community is the base abstract concept I use in all my work. I work with the theme of project in order to create a perfect fit for your public artwork.

I have had the opportunity to work with the Chinese community, a Middle Eastern corporation, and the city of Chicago to mention a few of my public artwork commissions. Each of these experiences has allowed me to research the space the art will reside, the people that will be exposed to the art the most, the history of the area and stories of the people in the community. Previously to being a public artist I was adjunct faculty at universities and colleges teaching graphic design. The studios environment is one of my favorite places to be and create. I also enjoy creating public art with children of all ages as well as adults. Engaging with people while creating art is fantastic and also allows me to interact with people that live in the area I am painting.

As you will see in my sample public art pieces, although I create abstract art I have incorporated or used specific images and icons to fit the theme of each public art I have completed. When I was creating the design for the Chinatown Library in Chicago we went through more than 20 revisions of the 10 foot by 60 foot piece. Each revision, small and large, was an idea from a different individual which made the creation expand into a beautiful piece that the community, the architects, public art works department, and the Mayor could relate to in a positive manner. I did not compromise any individual's idea but found a way to combine them all together working as one.

My work ethic and dedication to visually depict any theme combined with my style (literally, abstractly, or both) is why I am a fantastic candidate for public art projects. The desire to research and listen to the committee or panel that has laid out the theme directives and to create a variety of preliminary designs is my goal.

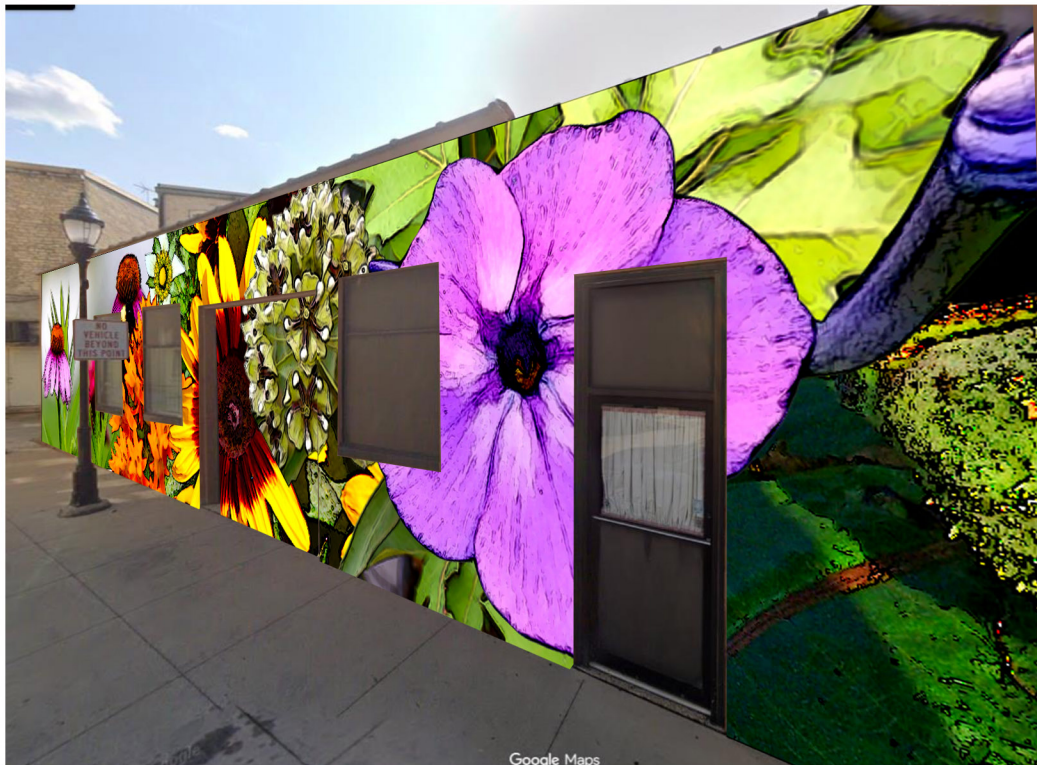
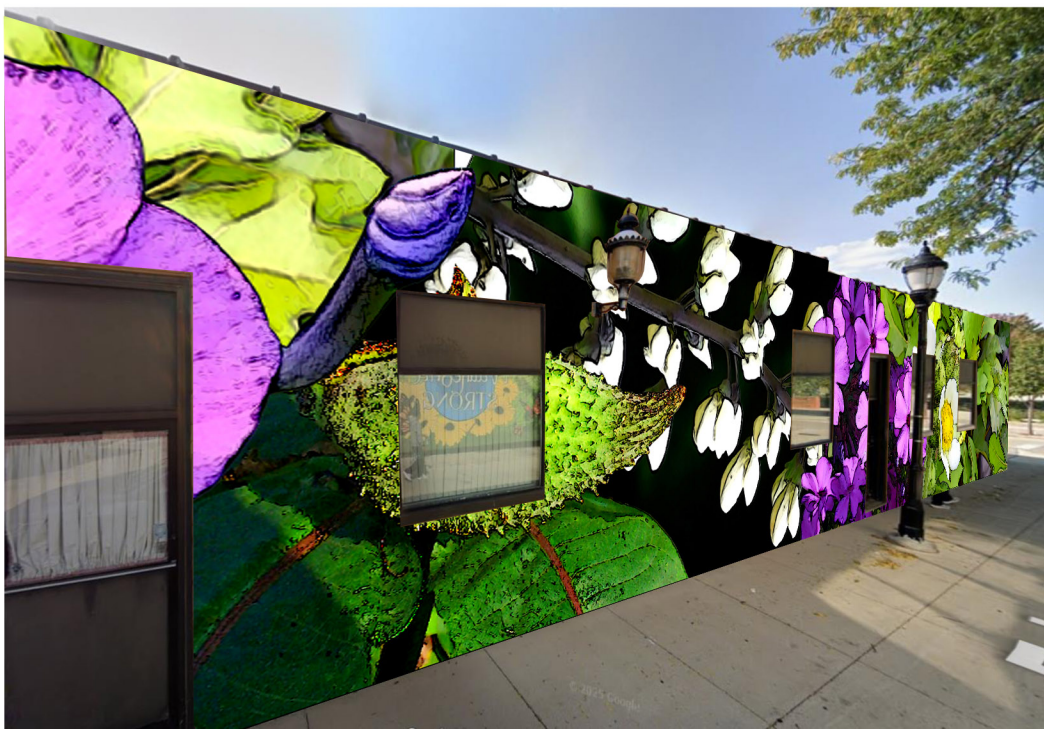

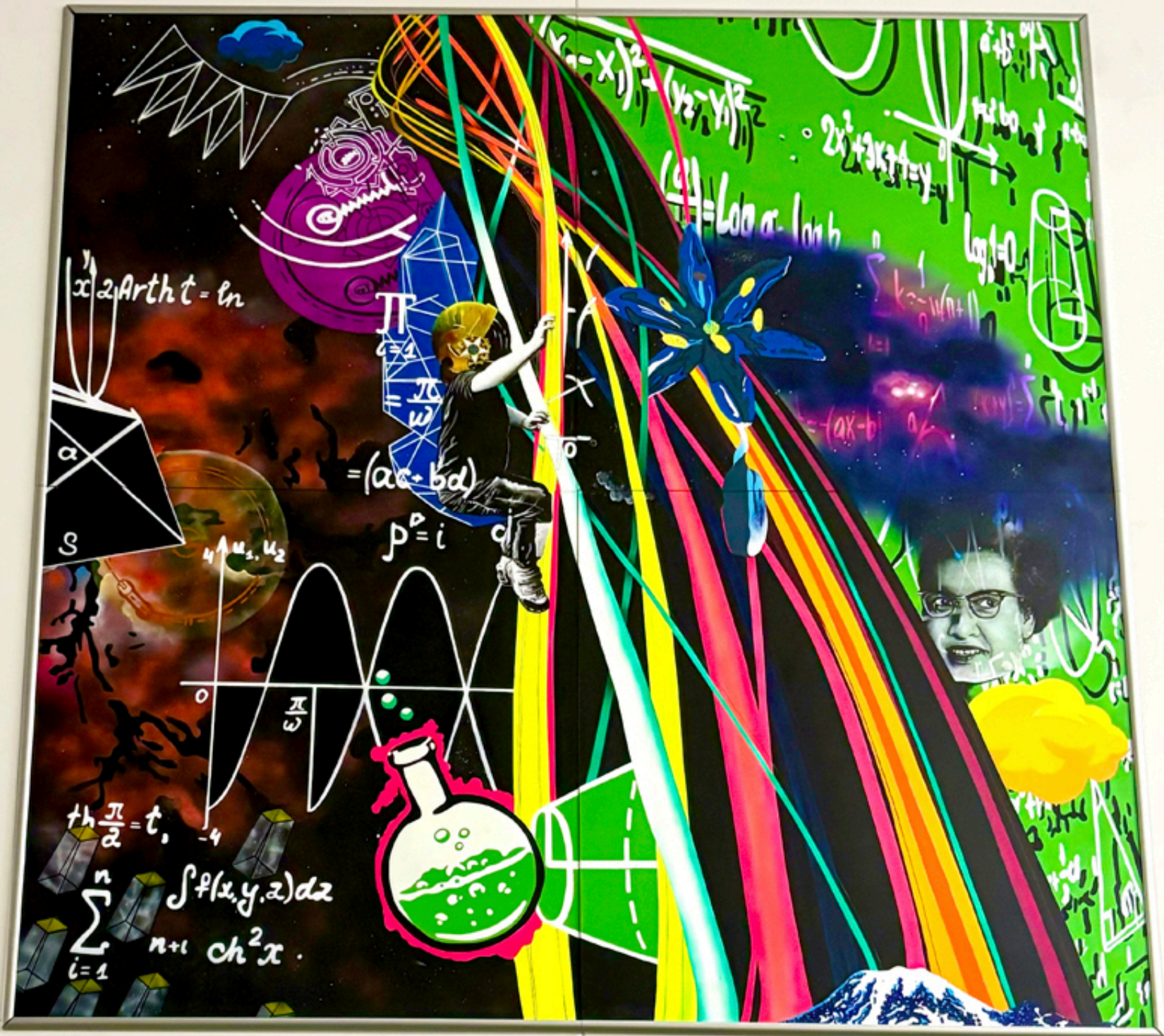
Project Budget, Schedule, & Preparation/Maintenance

I utilize stencils and projectors to create the design on the structure to be painted. I start with cleaning the surface where the art will be created and then prime the entire area with the KILZ product. I purchase high quality UV protected Behr paint and UV protected sealers called both of which have 10 year direct sunlight guarantees. After the mural is dry I apply multiple times a 2-part coating of anti-graffiti sealer called Murals Shield on the art. If the mural is defaced the damaged area can be fixed by cleaning it off with a towel and light cleaner such as Windex. If there is major damage I have the experience to be able to reconstruct the artworks surface and repaint the repaired area. With the Mural Shield sealer on the wall it can be cleaned or sprayed down as often as desired. If the commissioning agency would like me to use other specific painting and sealing products of their choice that is absolutely acceptable. The time frame for completion of the mural is based on the property owners' preference.

The project budget (\$35 per square foot and is negotiable) will cover all painting supplies, scissor lift/boom lift or scaffolding rental, travel, lodging, \$1,000,000 of Certified Liability insurance and any miscellaneous required materials. Once a final design is approved I can put together an itemized budget with the specific supplies. I am always willing to work out a fee to satisfy all parties involved in order to make sure the project can be completed with in a certain time frame and budget. As mentioned previously I can create the mural in the time frame requested since my only job is creating public artworks.

One of the reasons I enjoy doing public art throughout this country is the variety of different themes and communities I create the art for. Every project is unique and has specific requirements for that community. I get to meet the people, experience the food and atmosphere of the area, which adds to the creative process and partially molds the artwork that will reside in a space for that community.
