Resolution On Crosswalk Marking/Signs

Be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Waukesha, Wisconsin that the Board of Public Works in conformity with Chapter 349 Wisconsin Statutes is directed to place the following official traffic signs and signals at the intersections and upon the highways indicated; that said signs and signals shall be so located as to give adequate warning to users of the highway and no provision of the Traffic Ordinance of the City of Waukesha, with respect thereto, shall be enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

Install enhanced crosswalk marking and install pedestrian crossing warning signs at the Hoover Avenue midblock crossing at Mindiola Park. [ID#26-03697]

This resolution was approved at the June 1, 2026, Building and Grounds Committee meeting and brought forward to the June 16, 2026, Common Council meeting for approval under the Consent Agenda.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with or contravening this resolution are hereby repealed.
