### **Agenda Item Title:**

Review and possible action on Resolution No. 2025-25 A Resolution Establishing the Compensation of Common Council Members from April 21, 2026 through April 16, 2029

#### **Issue Before the Board/Council:**

Should Common Council Members's salary for District 2, 3, 6, 7, 10, and 13 be adjusted for the next term of office?

#### **Options & Alternatives:**

- 1. The Common Council could modify the salary adjustment to another annual amount.
- 2. The Common Council could maintain the existing salary for Common Council Members.

#### **Additional Details:**

Peer communities were surveyed to compare salaries for the Mayor, Council Members, Municipal Judge, and the City Attorney position. As you will see on the next page, the Common Council salaries vary quite a bit from city to city. Due to the variability of the tasks for this position it makes it very difficult to draw any conclusions based on a salary comparison. The Waukesha Common Council Members currently earns \$7,000 annually.
