Subject:

Review and act on the requests from Gary Kline, Susan Madonia, and Fred Werdermann for one-time sewer credits.

Details:

The City of Waukesha Municipal Code Chapter 29 requires sewer billing to be based upon the measured volume of water consumed and allows for a one-time unmetered credit. According to Chapter 29.11(h)(4) titled One-Time Unmetered Credit, users without credit meters may request an adjustment of sewer service charges for special circumstances such as filling of a swimming pool or establishing a new lawn.

- Gary Kline, 1732 Erin Ln, requested a one-time credit for sewer service charges for December 2024 and January 2025 for a leaking hose outside.
 Estimated Additional Usage: 6,816 gallons (2024, 2025) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$71.43
- Susan Madonia, 1224 Mohican Trail, requested a one-time credit for sewer service charges for October 2024 for a leaking sprinkler system.

Estimated Additional Usage: 20,187 gallons (2024) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$211.56

• Fed Werdermann, 1931 Rambling Rose, requested a one-time credit for sewer service charges for December 2024 for a leaking outside faucet.

Estimated Additional Usage: 15,422 gallons (2024) @ \$10.48/1000 gal = \$161.62

To not approve the one-time sewer credit or approve another dollar amount.
